

Cotton Owners Club celebrate Double Celebration.

The Cotton Owners club are coming together to celebrate a double celebration this Saturday the 10th of August 2024.

To celebrate the 70th anniversary of the takeover of the Cotton Motorcycle Company by the renowned engineer Pat Onions and the 30th anniversary of the Cotton Motorcycle Club, the largest collection of Cotton Motorcycles will be roaring up to the “The Folk of Gloucester” on Saturday the 10th of August 2024 from 10 am to 3 pm.

The Cotton factory was located just a few hundred metres from the venue, (which used to be The Folk Museum.)

Cotton Motorcycles went on to Smash 12 world records and winning the Famous Isle of Man TT multiple times from 1923 onwards

Prewar and post-war examples of these successful machines will be on display, some shiny examples and some well-used ones with plenty of patina. Other Cotton-related items will also be on display. Anyone is welcome to attend from 11am to 4:00 pm, entry is free.

To celebrate the 70th anniversary of Pat Onions taking over Cotton his surviving relatives will be presenting the awards for the best of the Show and helping to give a glimpse into the life of this quiet but remarkable man.

It is also the 30th anniversary of the formation of the Cotton Owners’ and Enthusiasts’ Club. Members will be there to talk to the public and hopefully answer any questions they may have. If there are any interesting stories relating to Cotton, the Club would love to hear them.
