## Roman Gloucester Walks

With a Civic Trust guide, learn why the Romans came to Gloucester. Discover Roman Walls in the Eastgate Chamber, walk down the site of the Forum and meet Emperor Nerva. See aspects of Roman life including mosaics, jewellery, weaponry and tombstones on display in the Museum.


Roman Walks start at 10.30 on the following Fridays:

## Discover the Eastgate Chamber

With a Civic Trust guide, visit the Eastgate Chamber and discover Roman walls , a medieval gate tower and a 16th century horsepool.

Chamber Tours start at 11.00 am on the following Fridays:

April 10th, 24th; May 1st, 15th, 29th; June 5th, 19th, 26th;  
July 10th, 24th, 31st; August 14th, 21st; Sept 4th, 25th.

Tickets £8 for adults, £3.50 for children under 16.  
(maximum 18 per tour) from the Museum (Brunswick Road) where tours start.

## Tours of the King's Bastion

With a Civic Trust guide, visit the underground chamber that contains the remains of a section of the Roman wall and a 13th century defensive tower. The Bastion is located under a trapdoor in the King's Walk Shopping Centre, opposite Superdrug.

Tours start at 10.30, 11.10 and 11.50 on the following dates: April 14th; May 26th; June 16th; July 21st; July 28th; August 18th.

Tickets £8 for adults, £5.50 for children 11+ (maximum 14 per tour) from the Museum (Brunswick Road)
